Conditions of Entry

- 1) Vehicles must arrive via Bridge Street by Banbury bus station between **7am – 9:30am** on Thursday 31st January. Vehicles arriving late whilst the event is in operation may not be permitted to display.
- 2) The event finishes at 3:30pm; vehicles will be permitted to leave after this time providing it is safe to do so. Cherwell District Council Officers will be responsible for coordinating access and egress from the event and will make the final decision on when vehicles can safely move within the event area.
- 3) This will be a static display and vehicle movements will be restricted to access and egress of the event area only.
- 4) Cherwell District Council stewards will be on hand to help park vehicles in their designated space; drivers should take extreme care with speeds not exceeding 10mph whilst in the event area.
- 5) Drivers of larger vehicles and trailers must ensure a banksman is present when reversing into position.
- 6) The planned display area is outlined green in the attached plan.
- 7) There won't be any onsite parking for support vehicles or trailers. An area has been set aside near Spiceball Park Road (OX16 2PA) as shown in the attached plan; the purple line shows the driving route from the event area, whilst the yellow line shows the quickest walk back (under 400m). Please inform us whether you will need to use this area.
- 8) Vehicles taking part in this event must be insured against third party risks by the owner. Cherwell District Council cannot take insurance responsibility for individual vehicles.
